IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- The June Culminating Activity/Exam timetable has been created and includes a day to account for student success and conflicts.
- **Students who are ill or late must contact the main office immediately at 613-389-8932**. An alternative time may be arranged. Being late for a final examination may result in less time to write the evaluation. Missing a final exam or culminating activity will be considered legitimate under the following circumstances: (a) medical reason with a doctor's certificate, or (b) family emergency with a parent/guardian note.
- Students must attend examinations as scheduled. Examinations can only be rescheduled in the case of a conflict (ie. two exams for one student scheduled at the same time). **Travel should not be scheduled during the examination period**. Any questions regarding attendance for the examination period should be directed to school administration.
- In the case of a conflict, students should speak with their classroom teacher and a member of the administration before the exam schedule begins. One examination will be rescheduled to an alternate agreeable time at the discretion of the classroom teachers and administration.
- Students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP) will be provided with accommodations as needed for each exam. Ms. Elvidge (Learning Program Support Teacher) will work with classroom teachers and students to ensure that accommodations are provided. Students with questions regarding their accommodations should connect with Ms. Elvidge.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXAM DAY

- Junior exams (grades 9 and 10) are up to 1.5 hours in length; Senior exams (grades 11 and 12) are up to 2 hours in length. Students must remain in the exam room for at least 1 hour.
- Students should report to the location of their exam 10 minutes prior to the start time.
- Students should bring textbooks for textbook return during the exam period.
- **Cell phones will not be permitted in exam rooms.**
- Only electronic devices as outlined in a student's IEP will be permitted in exam rooms.
- Students will not be permitted to be in the halls during exams.
- Bus transportation will run on exam days. **There is no mid-day bus.** Students with only one exam are welcome to be in the cafeteria or library during the other half of the day.
